PREAMBLE

The regatta will be managed in accordance with the provisions on combating and containing the spread of communicable diseases, including but not limited to COVID-19, issued by World Sailing. All participants (team support inclusive) and all other persons involved in the event in different roles (Sponsors, Media, Officials, Employees, club and board Members, Volunteers and Spectators) shall comply with these provisions. Any cases of communicable diseases, including but not limited to COVID 19 that may be detected during the event shall be reported by the Organizing Authority to the competent health authorities. Before the start of the event, any of the persons (but not limited to) mentioned above shall complete and deliver to the Organizing Authority the self-declaration form.

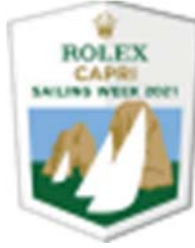

COVID-19 PROCEDURES and RULES

To ensure a safe COVID-19 free environment during the 2021 ROLEX Capri Sailing Week, the Organization will implement a regularly updated health compliance protocol based on the Italian Health Authorities' indications, in coordination with local health Authorities, Universities, and the Italian Sailing Federation. The following procedures and rules shall apply to the entirety of the regatta and any event related to the regatta.

1. Competitors will be required to register online by uploading all necessary documents onto their account on the race web site;
2. Each owner, crew member, race official, and member of staff will be required to present a negative COVID-19 molecular test (RT-PCR - Reverse Transcription-Polymerase Chain Reaction) dating back no more than two days preceding his/her first access to the mooring area or race village. Failure to do so will result in a prohibition from the event;
3. Once the test result is uploaded onto the registration form, participants' digital COVID-free pass ("CFP") will be activated to access the race village and the boats;
4. Participants already vaccinated against Covid-19 will automatically receive a CFP.
5. [DP] Access to the event site and race village will be subject to temperature screening upon entry and restricted exclusively to owners, crew members, race officials, and staff with a CFP. Failure to comply will result in prohibition from entering the race village;
6. To access the event site and race village, participants shall scan their CFP at the entrance.
7. Guests will not be allowed to access the race village and mooring areas, except in the case of an emergency;
8. Race officials and members of staff will be tested regularly throughout the event;
9. [DP] Crew members will be tested randomly throughout the event.
10. If a crew member tests positive for COVID-19, then the whole crew shall be placed in quarantine and tested. The boat shall not be allowed to compete for the rest of the event; the decision shall be in writing from the OA.
11. Access to the race office will be allowed exclusively upon reservation or under exceptional circumstances;
12. All race documents and notices will be posted online located at: <https://www.rolexcaprisailingweek.com/en/documents-2021> ;
13. Access to indoor spaces will be limited to ensure proper social distancing;
14. Crews will be required to avoid gatherings and to always wear face masks properly, except while onboard;
15. Participants will be required to clean and disinfect their hands regularly and to sanitize frequently touched surfaces and objects;
16. Consumption of food and drink is strictly limited to onboard. No eating or drinking on the docks or in race village;
17. Social events will be subject to national and local health prescriptions.



1. ROLEX CAPRI SAILING WEEK

1.1 The 2021 Rolex Capri Sailing Week includes:

a) The 66th Regata dei Tre Golfi, eligible for the 2021 FIV Italian Offshore Championship and also

part of the IMA Mediterranean Championship;

b) The 2021 ORC European Championship;

c) The 2021 Maxi Yacht Capri Trophy, part of IMA Mediterranean Inshore Challenge, and the Mylius Cup.

1.2 This Notice of Race applies to all events above except when otherwise indicated in brackets at the end of a sentence or a paragraph (i.e. 3G or ORCEC or MYCT).

1.3 The official languages of the Regatta are English and Italian. If there is a conflict between the two languages, the English text shall prevail (ORCEC and MYCT).

1.4 This NoR consists of three sections:

- General Section, common to all events;

- Section One, specific to the 2021 ORC European Championship;

- Section Two, specific to the 66th Regata dei Tre Golfi;

- Section Three, specific to the 2021 Maxi Yacht Capri Trophy and Mylius Cup.

1.5 The OA reserves the right to amend this NoR until May 6th 2021, by posting the new version on the event website and sending it by e-mail to the yachts already registered. Such notification shall be deemed to be in compliance with RRS 89.2(a).

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

2.1 Circolo Remo e Vela Italia, Yacht Club Capri and Yacht Club Italiano, under the patronage of FIV and in cooperation with IMA, AIVE, UVAI, Reale Yacht Club Canottieri Savoia, Comune di Capri and Porto Turistico di Capri.

2.2 The ORCEC is organized also under the jurisdiction of the ORC.

3. PROGRAM

3.1 The Rolex Capri Sailing Week will take place in the gulfs of Naples, Salerno and Gaeta and in the waters around Capri Island, according to the program hereafter.

3.2 RC has the authority to change the schedule of the races by posting on the ONB before 1900 hrs on the day before it will take effect.

3.3 a) No warning signal will be displayed after 1500 hrs on Friday, May 14th, except as a consequence of a general recall (MYCT).

b) No warning signal will be displayed after 1500 hrs on Thursday, May 20th, except as a consequence of a general recall (ORCEC).

4. ROLEX CAPRI SAILING WEEK TROPHIES (3G+MYCT)

4.1 Rolex Trophy to the Maxi yacht with the best combined scores between the 3G and the MYCT, considering all races sailed with no discard.

4.2 The races will have the following coefficients:

3G coefficient 2; Windward-Leeward races coefficient 1; Coastal races coefficient 1.25.

4.3 In the event of a tie between yachts, the one with the best score in the 3G shall be the winner.

- Capri ClubSwan Award to the Nautor's Swan yacht with the best final score in corrected time considering all classes taking part at all events including the ORCEC.
- YCI Trophy to the Yacht Club with the most competitors on the podium, considering all the events including the ORCEC.

5. ADVERTISING, TRACKING UNIT AND DAMAGE DEPOSIT

5.1 In accordance with RRS 6, World Sailing Advertising Code will apply.

5.2 Event advertising by the OA (see SI appendix 3):

- bow numbers with advertisement, to be displayed as forward as possible on both sides of the first 20% of the hull;
- advertisement to be displayed on both sides of the foremost 20% of the mainsail boom;
- sponsor's flag to be flown on the backstay throughout the entire event.

5.3 The OA may also require the installation, at no cost to the competitors, of on-board cameras, position devices and guest riders, who's on board position restrictions will be defined in the SI.

5.4 An electronic tracking system will be used for monitoring the nautical position of the yachts. The OA may use the information received for media coverage as well as for safety purposes.

5.5 Participants shall allow the installation of the tracking unit on their boats and shall be responsible for the unit while on board. They shall return the unit to the RO as soon as possible after finishing the race and will be required to leave a damage deposit of Euro 900, by credit card or check, in case the unit is not returned.

6. MEMBERSHIP AND REGISTRATION NATIONALITY

6.1 Italian crews shall have a valid 2021 FIV membership card, inclusive of medical prescription.

6.2 Non-Italian crews must comply with the rules of their National Authorities.

6.3 The registration nationality of a yacht is indicated by the owner of the yacht as set out in the entry form. If not indicated, the sail national letters on the mainsail or the owner's nationality will be used.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The SI will be available online at <https://www.rolexcaprisailingweek.com/en/documents-2021>.

8. INTERNATIONAL JURY, PENALTIES, REQUESTS OF REDRESS

8.1 An International Jury will be appointed in compliance with RRS 91(b) and Appendix N.

8.2 Decisions of the IJ will be final, in accordance with RRS 70.5.

8.3 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the "Two-Turns Penalty" is replaced by the "One-Turn Penalty" (MYCT).

8.4 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the "Two-Turns Penalty" is replaced by the "One-Turn Penalty" only for infringements outside the zone of a mark on the course (ORCEC).

8.5 Additional rules on penalties may be set in the SI.

8.6 Redress Limitation:

(a) Redress shall not be given to a yacht for a greater number of races than she completed during the regatta; this changes RRS 60.1(b) and RRS 62.1.

(b) Redress shall not be requested or given on the basis of tracking records or of images of the start or finish of a race, such as video, photographs or drone footage (MYCT); this changes RRS 60.1(b), 60.2(b), 60.3(b).

9. TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

The TC may inspect any boat before, between and after racing.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

10.1 All support boats shall be registered at the RO (DPI).

10.2 Identification numbers will be provided by the OA; these numbers shall be visible at all times.

10.3 Teams or their representatives shall not fly drones over the race areas during training or racing days unless prior written approval by the OA, which may impose similar limitations as applicable to support boats, and without complying with Italian Law. At any time, the risk and responsibility for flying any drone is with the person flying it. Images made within the racing area shall be shared with the OA, the Jury and competitors at reasonable request (DPI).

11. MOORINGS, VANS AND CONTAINERS

11.1 Subject to availability yachts registered for the event will be provided:

- a free of charge berth in Naples, Santa Lucia from Wednesday, May 12th to Saturday, 15th and in Capri from Sunday, 16th to Friday 21th (ORCEC);

- a free of charge berth in Capri from Sunday, May 9th to Saturday, 15th (MYCT and MC);
- a free of charge berth in Naples from Friday, 14th to Saturday, 15th (3G). Participants at 3G will be granted free of charge moorings for not more than 24 hours after their finishing time.

11.2 Registered boats that do not participate in any of the Capri regattas will be required to pay the applicable mooring fee.

11.3 It is mandatory to send an email to the RO at least 72 hours before the arrival. On their arrival, yachts shall inform the OA on:

- VHF ch. 74 (Naples)
- VHF ch. 71 (Capri).

11.4 The OA will assign a limited amount of free charge parking places for vans and containers in the Capri Marina, based on the chronological registration order.

12. MEDIA RIGHTS

Competitors, owners and their guests grant absolute right and permission to the OA for any photography and video footage taken of persons and boats during the event, to be published and/or broadcast in any media, including but not limited to TV advertisements, whatsoever for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information.

13. COMMUNICATIONS

Except for emergencies or when communicating with the RC, a racing yacht shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all other boats.

14. INSURANCE

Participants shall be insured with valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of EURO 1,500,000. The responsibility to hold adequate insurance cover for Tort Liability and Third-Party Insurance (Property and Persons) is to the owners or the skippers alone.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

According to World Sailing RRS fundamental Decision to Race: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone", all sailors take part in the regatta at their own risk and under their responsibility. The OA, including CRVI, YCC, YCI, FIV, ORC, IMA, ROLEX and other sponsors, the PRO, RC, IJ, TC and any other party involved accept no liability for any damage that may subject persons and/or property, both ashore and afloat, as a result of their participation in the races under these instructions.

The OA reminds the owners and managers on board that they respond personally to all accidents that can happen to their boats and/or their crews.

Thus, they will have to contract the necessary insurance to cover all risks including those from third parties.

The owners and skippers are also responsible for the decision to take part in a race based on wind strength, sea conditions and available weather forecast.

The OA, cannot provide personal assistance except in case of emergency, in which case the Maritime Authority (Capitaneria di Porto) will be responsible. For this reason, all boats shall have all local stations including a VHF radio able to transmit and receive on channel 16 (rescue channel). As a consequence of a breach of behavior on sportsmanship, the IJ can ban a team from continuing the regatta or may apply other disciplinary actions. This holds for all events, both ashore and afloat; the owner or his representative is responsible for the crew behavior.

Notice is hereby given to all participants including officials, volunteers, and others that they participate in this event solely at their own risk and voluntarily assume the risks associated with communicable diseases, including, but not limited to, COVID-19.



16. VENUES, DATES AND COURSES

16.1 The 2021 ORC European Championship will take place in the gulfs of Naples, Salerno and Gaeta (offshore race) and in the waters around Capri island (windward/ leeward races).

16.2 The offshore race will start at 22.00 hrs on Saturday, May 15th 2021 from Santa Lucia cove, Naples, on the same course as the 66th Regata dei Tre Golfi (see Section Two, 26).

16.3 The courses will be further detailed in the SI.

17. RULES

17.1 The Regatta will be governed by:

a) The rules as defined in the 2021-2024 RRS;

b) National Prescriptions will not apply, except as defined in NoR 6.1;

c) 2020-2021 WS Offshore Special Regulations Category 3. The life raft is only mandatory for the offshore race, the AIS is not mandatory;

d) 2021 IMS Rules;

e) 2021 ORC Rating System Rules.

17.2 Under RRS 87, ORC Rule 206 is changed as follows:

a) All sails shall be measured and stamped by an ORC measurer. During the pre-race equipment inspection, sails can be marked for the event by stamp, sticker and/or inspector's signature.

b) The maximum number of sails shall be as defined in ORC Rule 206, with one additional mainsail allowed. The second mainsail shall have a minimum of one set of reef points. The mainsails may be interchangeable.

c) With the exception of the second mainsail all other sails shall be on board while racing.

d) Sails that have been damaged during the events may be repaired. Sails beyond repair may be replaced with the approval of the TC.

17.3 Minimum crew weight as defined in ORC Rules 102.3 and 200.1(b) shall apply.

18. ELIGIBILITY AND CLASSES

18.1 Competitors shall comply with the World Sailing Eligibility Code.

18.2 The Regatta is open to all boats with valid ORC International certificate with $8.6 < CDL < 16.5$. The flotation date on an ORC International Certificate shall not be earlier than May 10th 2015.

18.3 Classes are defined by the CDL as follows:

Class A: $16.400 > CDL > 11.590$

Class B: $11.590 > CDL > 9.770$

Class C: $9.770 > CDL > 8.560$

18.4 The number of boats in a class plus the number of countries shall be not less than 14. If the minimum number of boats is not reached in a class, the OA can merge it with the nearest one. In this case, only one Championship title will be assigned to the combined classes.

18.5 Non-European boats are allowed to enter the event but will not be eligible for the Championship.

18.6 Classes will have separate starts and separate results.

18.7 Due to the limited number of moorings available in the Capri Marina, the maximum number of entries amongst all classes is 100.

Subject to the availability of additional mooring places, the OA may allow entries in excess of the previous limit.

18.8 The maximum number of boats per country in each class is 30.

18.9 Eligible boats may pre-register until Monday, March 1st 2021 by completing the online registration form on the event's website: www.rolexcaprisailingweek.com

18.10 A boat will be considered pre-registered if the following documents are received:

a) entry form;

b) entry fee payment confirmation.

18.11 The list of pre-registered boats will be updated on the event's website upon reception of each new entry including the entry fee payment.

18.12 If less than 100 yachts are pre-registered before Monday, March 1st 2021 all of them will be accepted as final entries.

Additional entries will be accepted up to Friday, March 19th 2021, based on the chronological order of registration and until the maximum number of 100 boats is reached.

18.13 If more than 100 yachts are pre-registered before Monday, March 1st 2021 final entries will be accepted at the Organizers' discretion, in agreement with the ORC, by considering:

A. registration to the 2020 ORC EC edition, confirmed after the postponement due to COVID-19;

B. international representation of the fleet;

C. adequate representation of the various classes;

D. boat's and skipper's racing record, particularly in recent ORC Championships;

E. chronological order in which boats are pre-registered.

18.14 The final list of accepted entries will be published on the event's website by Monday, March 22th 2021.

18.15 Pre-registered boats whose entry is not accepted will be allocated in a "waiting list" and, based on their ranking, can replace any of the accepted boats that cancel their participation before the start of the Championship.

18.16 The entry fee received from any boat whose entry is not accepted will be refunded.

18.17 Entry fees paid by accepted entries will not be refunded if the boat does not participate at the Championship.

19. CORINTHIAN DIVISION AND TROPHY

19.1 For the Corinthian Division and Trophy, the World Sailing Sailor Classification Code, RRS 6 Regulation 22 shall apply and all crew members shall hold a valid Group 1 classification. Unclassified sailors will be deemed to be Group 3. A boat entered in the Corinthian Division shall also be entered automatically in the Open Division and shall be eligible for prizes and trophies in both divisions. Details of the World Sailing Sailor Classification Code and information on how to apply can be found on World Sailing website: www.sailing.org/classification.

19.2 The closing date for the reception of valid Corinthian entries is Sunday, May 2nd 2021. Each entry shall include a complete crew list, classification and World Sailing Sailor ID of each crew. Prior to this date, all crew members must hold valid classifications that will not expire until after the final day of the Regatta.

Late entries and incomplete entries cannot be considered for this division.

19.3 Should a boat, whose Corinthian entry has been checked and accepted, need to change a crew member between the closing date of the entry and the start of the Regatta, the name of the new crew member including a valid World Sailing Sailor ID shall be submitted to the OA and the IJ for their approval. All crew lists will be posted on the ONB or website as soon as possible after the Registration deadline.

Note: A representative of the World Sailing Sailor Classification Commission will be present during registration and will carry out random inspections. Competitors shall attend interviews with the Commission when requested to do so.

Competitors are reminded that the Commission has the power to change a classification at the event with no prior notice. Any changes are effective immediately.

20. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

20.1 Entries completed before 2400 hrs of Monday, March 1st 2021 are subject to the following fees (net of any bank charges):

- Class A Euro 900
- Class B Euro 800
- Class C Euro 700

20.2 Entries completed after Monday, March 1st 2021 may be accepted at Organizer's discretion with a 50% surcharge.

20.3 The OA is not responsible for any costs incurred by the non-acceptance of a boat's registration nor for any delay, postponement or cancellation of the race due to causes not under the control of the OA.

20.4 Support boats and trucks shall be registered during the registration period; they shall be clearly identified by an official flag supplied by the OA. Due to the limited amount of space in the Capri Marina it is mandatory to ask the OA for authorization (DPI).

21. REGISTRATION

21.1 Each owner or skipper shall register in the Race Office located at Circolo Remo e Vela Italia, Naples, from 1000 hrs of Thursday, May 13th to 1200 hrs of Saturday May 15th 2021.

21.2 The following documents shall be uploaded online prior to registration. A boat shall not be considered registered until all documents are supplied (This changes RRS 78.2):

- a) a valid ORC measurement certificate issued before Thursday, May 13th 2021;
- b) crew list including a valid World Sailing ID and the weight for each crew member;
- c) a valid third-party liability insurance of Euro 1,500,000;
- d) liability acceptance form, correctly filled out and signed;
- e) advertising license, if applicable;
- f) personal contact details
- g) negative COVID-19 molecular test (RT-PCR Reverse Transcription-Polymerase Chain Reaction).

21.3 No changes shall be made to the ORC International certificates after Thursday, May 13th 2021, unless prescribed and approved by the TC before or during the pre-race equipment inspection and in any event before the start of the first race.

21.4 Crew lists may be amended up to 1200 hrs on Saturday, May 15th 2021 by filling a new form showing the changes. After this time, changes in the crew list may only be made with written permission of the RC.

21.5 The time limit for a protest by a boat regarding the World Sailing's Sailor Classification Code is 1900 hrs on Saturday, May 15th 2021. This changes RRS 61.3.

22. SCHEDULE AND VALIDITY OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

22.1 Seven races are scheduled, of which six inshore and one offshore.

22.2 Inshore races will be windward-leeward races, except when unusual or extreme local conditions make it impossible to sail a windward/leeward course, then the IJ may give permission to sail a substitute course.

22.3 The Championship is valid if at least three races are completed, including the offshore race.

22.4 One discard is allowed if at least four races are completed; the offshore race shall not be discarded.

23. SCORING

23.1 The "Low Point" scoring system of RRS Appendix A shall apply.

23.2 Windward/leeward race results will be determined by corrected times calculated by Performance Curve Scoring and constructed Course Method.

23.3 Offshore race results will be determined by corrected times, calculated by Performance Curve Scoring for all purpose pre-selected Course.

24. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

24.1 From 0900 hrs of Saturday, May 15th until the end of the last scheduled race, boats shall not be hauled out, except for the purposes of repairing damage and only after written permission from the TC.

24.2 While hauled for the above purpose, cleaning and polishing of the hull below the waterline will not be permitted.

24.3 Rudders shall not be removed from the water during the events, nor shall the centerboards be removed from their cases.

24.4 In accordance with Italian law diving inside the harbor is forbidden.

25. TROPHIES AND PRIZES

25.1 The following awards will be presented (the final list will be posted on the ONB):

- Rolex Trophy to the first yacht in each Class;
- Trophies to the 2nd and 3rd yachts in each Class;
- Prizes to the best yachts in the Corinthian division.

25.2 European championship titles will be awarded to the first European boats in each Class.

26. VENUE, DATE AND COURSES

26.1 The 66th Regata dei Tre Golfi will take place in the gulfs of Naples, Salerno and Gaeta.

26.2 The race will start from Naples, Santa Lucia cove, at 22.30 hrs of Saturday, May 15th and finish in Capri after rounding Ponza island and Li Galli rocks.

26.3 Classic Yachts after the start will round Ventotene island and finish in Capri.

26.4 The courses will be further detailed in the SI.

26.5 Multihulls will start from Naples, Santa Lucia cove, at 23.00 hrs of Saturday, May 15th and finish in Capri, after rounding Ponza Island and a mark located off Santa Maria di Castellabate. The courses will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

27. RULES

27.1 The Race will be governed by:

- a) The rules as defined in the 2021-2024 RRS;
- b) 2021-2024 FIV Prescriptions to the RRS;
- c) 2020-2021 Offshore Special Regulations Category 3, with mandatory life raft, AIS is not mandatory;
- d) 2021 NFVA Offshore Regulation. It is mandatory for each crew member to wear a personal flotation device (PFD) with waterproof strobe light when on the deck at night;
- e) 2021 IMS-ORC rules;
- f) 2021 IRC Rules;
- g) 2021 IRC Rule, Parts A, B and C:
 - g.1) IRC Rule 22.4.2 is disregarded and replaced with: "The maximum number of crew members on board shall be the crew number printed on her certificate. There is no weight limit" (Maxi Yachts only);
- h) 2021 IMA Class Rules;

i) CIM Rules;

j) MOCRA Rating Rule.

27.2 Photographs, videos and any data, including tracking data, shall not be used as evidence at protest hearings (this changes RRS 63.6).

27.3 From 2030 to 0530 CEST, the Part 2 rules of RRS shall not apply and shall be replaced by IRPCS.

27.4 This paragraph only applies to the Maxi Yachts taking part at 3G:

a) If allowed by the class rules, canting keels, moveable appendages and water ballast are permitted if declared on the measurement or class certificate (this changes RRS 51).

b) If allowed by class rules, steering, ram and winch systems powered by force other than manual are permitted (this changes RRS 52).

c) Electric or electronic devices are permitted but shall not be used to helm or operate the boat's sailing systems, including appendages, except in case of emergencies or if permitted by class rules.

d) Exceptions to RRS 77 may be granted by the OA upon written request prior to the close of registration (this changes RRS 77).

28. ELIGIBILITY

28.1 Entries are restricted to yachts with a LH > of 6.00m if with a CE certification category, A or B, otherwise with LH > 9.00m, with a valid measurement / class certificate under the rule indicated. Sport boats are not allowed to take part at this event. The following classes will be offered:

- Maxi yachts: LH > 18.29m: IRC rating;
- ORC yachts: allocated to groups A and B as per 20210 NFVA;
- IRC yachts: allocated on their group based on the ORC class with at least ten entries in each group;
- 3GX2: ORC rating double-handed yachts; at least one crew member shall have a valid World Sailing offshore personal survival training course certificate. ORC will offer for free the new "ORC Double Handed Olympic Certificate" - created upon request of World Sailing - to all double gender crew. Moreover, ORC will offer a special prize to the best performing double gender crew racing under this new Certificate.
- Classic Yachts with a valid CIM rating, according to the requirements listed in the articles 2.3 and 3.3 of 2018/2021 CIM rules;
- Multihulls.

28.2 Except the X2 yachts, also eligible for the ORC overall result, dual entry of a yacht in two classes/ groups is not permitted.

28.3 Changing class or group is not permitted after entry has closed.

28.4 The OA may, at her sole discretion, add other classes/groups.

29. ENTRIES

29.1 Entries shall be completed before 2400 hrs of Monday, April 19th 2021 on:

www.rolexcaprisailingweek.com

Entries must include the payment of the entry fee and the following documents (this changes RRS 78.2):

a) a valid 2021 measurement/class certificate;

b) crew list;

c) 2021 FIV membership card of each Italian crew (non- Italian see NoR 6.2);

d) an adequate valid third party liability insurance;

e) advertising license, if applicable.

f) negative COVID-19 molecular test (RT-PCR - Reverse Transcription-Polymerase Chain Reaction).

29.2 Entry fees:

- Maxi Euro 1.800 (including both 3G and MYCT)
- Multihulls Euro 2.000
- All other boats Euro 400

29.3 Late entries will be accepted at the OA's discretion at a 50% surcharge.

29.4 Competitors shall be born before January 1st 2009.

29.5 Competitors who are less than 18 years old shall present at registration a declaration form, available on the event website, signed by parents or legal guardian who must give consent.

29.6 Support boats and trucks shall be registered during the registration period; they shall be clearly identified by an official flag supplied by the OA.

Due to the limited amount of space in the Capri Marina it is mandatory to ask the OA for authorization (DP).

30. CERTIFICATIONS AND INSPECTIONS

Each yacht shall have a valid measurement/class certificate issued before Thursday, May 13th 2021.

31. SCORING, TROPHIES AND PRIZES

31.1 ORC results will include yachts participating in the ORC EC and will be calculated on the basis of "Time on Distance".

31.2 IRC results will be based on "Time on Time".

31.3 Multihulls results will be calculated on the basis of "TCF".

31.4 The following awards will be presented (the final list will be posted on the ONB):

- Coppa Senatore Andrea Matarazzo

(perpetual challenge): to the first ORC yacht on corrected time (3G and ORCEC);

- Coppa Mariano Verusio

(perpetual challenge): to the first Maxi yacht on IRC corrected time;

- Coppa Gustavo d'Andrea

(perpetual challenge): to the first yacht on line honours;

- Coppa Beppe Knight

(perpetual challenge): to the first 3GX2 yacht on corrected time;

- Coppa Guido Imperiali di Francavilla

(perpetual challenge): to the first Classic Yacht on corrected time;

- Targa Beppe Knight

(perpetual challenge) to the first Multihull on corrected time.

31.5 Other prizes will be awarded to the first three yachts in each category/group with at least 10 entries, to the first two if at least 6 entries and to the first yacht only if there are less than 6 entries.

32. VENUE AND DATE

Regatta will take place in the waters around Capri Island from Monday, May 10th to Friday, May 14th 2021.

33. RULES

33.1 The Regatta will be governed by:

- a) the rules as defined in the 2021-2024 RRS;
- b) 2020-2021 OSR Category 3;
- c) 2021 IRC Rules;
- d) 2021 IRC Rule, Parts A, B and C;
- e.1) According to IRC Rules 21.1.5 (d) and (e) this Regatta is a four day event and the sails carried on board need to remain the same for each day of racing but not for the duration of the whole event. Each day begins when a boat leaves the mooring for the first time that day and ends when the boat returns to the mooring after the final race of that day;
- e.2) IRC Rule 22.4.2 is disregarded and replaced with: "The maximum number of crew members on board shall be the crew number printed on her certificate. There is no weight limit";
- f) 2021 IMA Class Rules.

33.2 Photographs, videos and any data, including tracking data, shall not be used as evidence at protest hearings (this changes RRS 63.6).

33.3 If allowed by class rules and if declared on the measurement or class certificate, canting keels, moveable appendages and water ballast are permitted (this changes RRS 51).

33.4 If allowed by class rules, steering, ram and winch systems powered by force other than manual are permitted (this changes RRS 52).

33.5 Electric or electronic devices are permitted but shall not be used to helm or operate the boat's sailing systems, including appendages, except for emergencies or if permitted by class rules.

33.6 Exceptions to RRS 77 may be granted by the OA upon written request prior to the close of registration (this changes RRS 77).

34. CERTIFICATIONS AND INSPECTIONS

Each yacht shall have a valid IRC measurement/class certificate issued before Monday May 10th 2021.

35. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

35.1 Entries are restricted to the following yachts:

- a) Maxi Yacht Capri Trophy: yachts with LH > 18.29 m. Entries may be allocated by the OA, at their sole discretion, to classes based on the number and diversity of entries. Each class will have a separate scoring but may be combined in a single starting sequence.
- b) Mylius Cup: yachts built by Mylius Yacht Shipyard.

35.2 Due to the limited number of moorings available in the Capri Marina, the maximum number of entries is 30 yachts.

The OA may allow registrations beyond this limit based on the availability of additional berths.

35.3 Yachts may pre-register until Monday, March 1st 2021 by completing the online registration form at: www.rolexcaprisailingweek.com.

35.4 A yacht will be considered pre-registered if the following documents are received:

a) entry form;

b) entry fee payment confirmation.

35.5 The list of pre-registered yachts will be updated on the event's website upon receipt of each new entry.

35.6 If less than 30 yachts are pre-registered before Monday, March 1st 2021, all of them will be accepted as final entries.

Additional entries will be allowed up to Friday, March 19th 2021, until the maximum number of 30 boats is reached.

35.7 If more than 30 yachts are pre-registered before Monday, March 1st 2021 final entries will be accepted at the Organizer's discretion, in agreement with IMA, by considering:

- confirmed registration to the postponed 2020 edition;
- international representation of the fleet;
- adequate representation of the various classes;
- yacht and skipper racing records;
- chronological order in which the yachts are pre-registered.

35.8 The final list of accepted entries will be published on the event's website by Monday, March 22nd 2021.

35.9 Pre-registered yachts whose entry is not accepted will remain on the "waiting list" and could replace any accepted boats that withdraw their participation before the Regatta starts.

35.10 Entry fees paid by accepted entries will not be refunded if the yacht does not participate at the Regatta.

36. ENTRY FEE AND REGISTRATION

36.1 The Entry Fee of Euro 1.800 includes the participation to the 66th Regata dei Tre Golfi (see NoR 29.2) and to MYCT.

36.2 Entries completed after Monday March 1st 2021 may be accepted at the OA's discretion with a 50% surcharge.

36.3 The OA is not responsible for any cost incurred by the non-acceptance of a yacht's registration nor for any delay, postponement or cancellation of the race due to causes not under the control of the OA.

36.4 Competitors shall be born before January 1st 2009.

36.5 Competitors who are less than 18 years old shall present at registration a declaration form, available on the event website, signed by parents or legal guardian who must give consent.

36.6 Support boats and trucks shall be registered during the registration period; they shall be clearly identified by an official flag supplied by the OA. Due to the limited amount of space in the Capri Marina it is mandatory to ask the OA for authorization (DP).

36.7 Each owner or skipper shall register in the RO located at Capri Marina, from 10.00 to 18.00 hrs of Monday, May 10th 2021.

36.8 The following documents shall be presented at registration:

- a) a valid IRC measurement certificate;
- b) crew list, including a valid World Sailing ID for each crew member;
- c) an adequate and valid third party liability insurance;
- d) liability acceptance form, correctly filled out and signed;
- e) advertising license, if applicable;
- e) personal contact details.

37. RACING AREA AND COURSES

37.1 Races will be sailed in the Bay of Naples and in the waters around Capri island.

37.2 The courses will be further detailed in the SI.

38. NUMBER OF RACES, COURSES AND VALIDITY

38.1 The Regatta will be considered valid if two or more races are completed.

38.2 A maximum of two windward-leeward races and one coastal race may be scheduled per racing day.

39. SCORING AND TROPHIES

39.1 The “Low Point” scoring system of Appendix A shall apply, but one discard will be only allowed if four or more races are completed. IRC results will be calculated on the basis of “Time on Time”.

39.2 Windward-leeward races will have coefficient of 1, coastal races of 1.25.

39.3 Trophies (the final list will be posted on the ONB):

- Maxi Yacht Capri Trophy (IMA trophy): to the first yacht in each class. Additional trophies are provided to the 2nd and 3rd yachts of each class with at least six entries per class, otherwise to the best two yachts.

- Mylius Cup: to the first Mylius yacht.

Additional trophies are provided to the 2nd and 3rd yachts of each class with at least six entries per class, otherwise to the best two yachts.

40. HAULING OUT AND DIVING (DPI)

40.1 Yachts shall not be hauled out, without written authorization of the PRO, starting from 2400 hrs before the first warning signal of the regatta until the end of the final race.

40.2 In accordance with Italian law, diving inside the harbor is strictly forbidden.
